Utilities

Utilities are programs that are part of the OS and are expected to carry out commonly occurring tasks that the OS is expected to do.

File Handlers

Saving, Renaming and deleting files.

Drivers

 Small programs that tell the OS how to controll the hardware. e.g Printers

Virous Checker

 Scans files and folders for harmfull or corrupted data.

Compression Software

 To make files smaller, so they can be transmitted more quickly.

Backing up

- The process of making another copy of a file in case anything adverse happens to the originnal
- A number of points will be considered
- Who will make the back up(automatic)
- when and how offten will it be made
- how many coppies, what type of medium
- where the coppies will be stored
- how long the coppies will be kept for

Archiving

- Archiving is done in order to save space on the main storage device
- Files which are barely ever used are coppied (usually in compressed form) to another medium.
- This is done because they may be needed in the future, but are not currently being used, and just take up loads of space.
- May be used for reference, legal or tax reasons.
